Measurements are comparisons of properties against accepted standards, called units.

## ENGLISH / US SYSTEM OF UNITS:

$$
\begin{gathered}
1 \text { foot }=12 \text { inches } \quad 1 \text { yard }=3 \text { feet } \quad 1 \text { mile }=1260 \text { yards } \\
5280 \text { feet }=1 \text { mile }
\end{gathered}
$$

So what's the problem?

1) English units require lots of memorization, as each kind of unit has completely different conversions to memorize.
2) English units are not easy to calculate mentally.
